

The Road To Emmaus (5 minute skit) by M.C. Conti

Luke 24:13-35

Two actors are walking in place and having a conversation

Cleopas: Wait, this is silly. We can't pretend to walk the entire time we do this.

Actor 2: but they walked the whole way in the Bible story.

Cleopas: we have creative licensing.

Actor 2.: What do you have in mind?

Cleopas: Follow my lead. I sure am tired. *(He speaks the next line overly dramatically)* Look, there are some chairs for us to sit in.

Actor 2: It's 33 AD. They didn't have plastic chairs.

Cleopas: Ok, fine. Look at these weirdly shaped rocks. They are perfect for us to sit in.

Actor 2: We couldn't have had a rock built for the skit?

Cleopas: Just sit down!

Jesus *(wearing a silly disguise)*: Well, hello there. What's the good word?

Cleopas: There is no good word today.

Jesus: Why not?

Actor 2: Are you for real? You have to be the only guy in town who doesn't know what just happened.

Jesus: So tell me what happened.

(A third chair is slid onto the stage and Jesus moves it in place next to the other ones then looks at the audience)

Jesus *(to the audience)*: The lesser-known miracle of Jesus creating a rock from out of nowhere. *(he winks.)* So what's up?

Actor 2: I'm assuming you know the guy they call Jesus the Nazarene?

Jesus *(smiles to the audience)*: I've heard of him, yes.

Cleopas: He was a man of God, a prophet.

Actor 2: He was like the coolest guy I'd ever met.

Cleopas: He said things that changed our lives.

Actor 2: He said things that changed the world.

Jesus: Sounds like a pretty great guy.

Cleopas: He was.

Jesus: Was?

Actor 2: Yeah. Our high priests and leaders got tired of him stirring things up. So they betrayed him, tried him, and sentenced him.

Cleopas: And 3 days ago, they had him put to death. You really haven't heard any of this?

Jesus: It's starting to sound familiar.
